#### ONGOING:

- Road Commission for Kalamazoo County bank search: continuing to meet with me to narrow down a watershed to focus finding a suitable bank site.
- Coordinating road commission(s) to sponsor the purchase of private mitigation bank credits in the thumb area. Availability in the Cass, Flint, and Black River (Port Huron) Watersheds.

- Planning to connect with the MMWA program again this spring to review status of EGLE approval for credits MiWB purchased at various sites in lower Michigan.
- Continuing to work with EGLE to review an older existing habitat assessment of a large dune/swale complex in St. Clair County for preservation mitigation credits.
- Following up with Chippewa County Road Commission to final the survey needed to close the Neebish Island site with EGLE. Returning remaining funds obligated to MiWB fund balance.
- 6. Continuing to attend the council meetings.
- Still working on the updates to our website, including map development. Hope to have it completed before our next meeting.
