• Credit use to date – Keweenaw and Perry site been used by about 60 projects todate

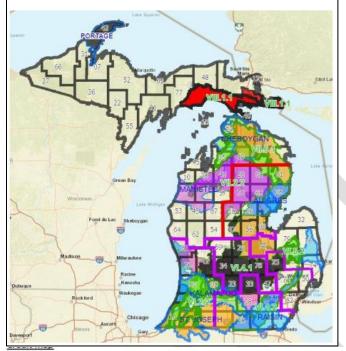
Possible future directions
